Exit 249C Williams St. Right onto Ivan Allen Jr. Blvd.
Left into parking garage at the second traffic light

Northbound via I-75/85:

Exit 249D Spring St./W. Peachtree St.
Turn right onto Spring St. ramp toward Centennial Olympic
Park Dr. and bear right onto Centennial Olympic Park Dr.
Take immediate left at traffic light onto Ivan Allen Jr. Blvd.
Parking garage is on the left at the first traffic light

Eastbound or Westbound via I-20:

Exit I-75/85 North and follow Northbound via I-75/85 route

PARKING

Parking is available in the World of Coca-Cola parking garage for a fee of \$10 per vehicle per day. Buses and vehicles larger than 7'H x 8'W x 16'L will qualify as oversized and cannot be accommodated in the Pemberton Place® parking garage. Visitors can utilize the Georgia World Congress Center bus marshalling yard for a fee of \$25 per vehicle per day. Buses should plan to utilize our bus lane along Baker Street for drop-off and pick-up of passengers.

ACCESSIBILITY

The World of Coca-Cola and the Pemberton Place® parking garage are disabled accessible and meet all A.D.A. requirements. Please feel free to bring your own wheelchair. Courtesy wheelchairs are available at the World of Coca-Cola ticket windows located at the main entrance. A photo ID will be requested in order to use a courtesy wheelchair.

ASSISTIVE LISTENING DEVICES

Handheld text and audio devices that utilize a wireless infrared system are available at the Guest Services desk in the Lobby.

BABY STROLLERS AND MOBILITY SCOOTERS

Baby strollers are welcome at the World of Coca-Cola. Single strollers are encouraged, as peak attendance periods may require restricted stroller use in certain areas. Power chairs and mobility scooters are also welcome, however during peak attendance periods, conventional wheelchairs are encouraged.
